### **STEP 1: Purchasing Tickets**

- 1. Click on <u>isoa.ticket.qtego.us</u> for reservations.
- 2. Scroll to Purchase Event
  Tickets and Ticket and Package Options. Click
  the tickets you prefer (Gold, Silver).
- 3. An Order Summary Box appears on the

right with your total. Click **Edit Guest Info.**, typing requested information - the names of guests and their email addresses.

- 4. Click next and view the **Donate** box. (See below)
- 5. **Special Requests.** Follow the instructions.
- 6. Payment Information. Make sure your email is included to receive confirmation.
- 7. Create a Qtego account to bid online and sign up for parties online, and Click Submit.

8. People writing checks may turn in the Response Card that came with the invitation.

#### **Step 2: Registering for the Auction**

- 1.Go to the Homepage and in the upper right click on **Register for the Event**.
- 2. Fill in your information and click **Submit Registration**. You will be sent a personal pin on your mobile phone. Type in the code. You are now registered to view the silent auction items. Bidding is available one week before the event.
