### Old Business:

- Old Westmore School Site Park Designation Update
  - Councilman Ross followed up from our last meeting and discovered that the Old Westmore School site was in fact designated by the city council as a park.
  - Improvements need to be made (sidewalks, etc.) but funding is a challenge.
  - Temporary signage for the near future.
  - Re-naming the park could be a long-term goal.
- Walmart / Lidl & Rust Road Entrance of Route 29 Update
  - Beth researched the issue and the property owner is responsible to keep up the road/ lane/stripping, in coordination with the Fairfax City Council.
- Fairfax Presbyterian Church Townhouse Proposal- Next Steps
