## Refer a new family to any Mosaic Early Childhood facility and receive a \$100 TUITION CREDIT

Have the family fill out the bottom of this form and make sure they know to hand it to the facility's Executive Director or Administrator upon registration. You will receive a \$100 tuition credit after the new family has been in enrollment and attending for four consecutive weeks. New enrollee must be registered for a minimum of two full days per week.

So, spread the word that Mosaic is the best early childhood education facility in Skokie and Chicago and save some money too!

Program does not include registrants to the before and after school programs (including pick up and drop off), holiday or summer camps. The new family must be in good standing. If more than one family refers the same family, the tuition credit will be split at Mosaic's discretion. Your name must appear on this form to be eligible. Children enrolled in Action for Children (AFC), Niles Township Scholarship, and Preschool For All are not eligible for tuition credit. This may not be combined with any other promotions or discounts. The tuition credit has no cash value and is non-refundable, and can only be used on tuition (it may not be applied to late fees and cannot be used to cover more than one week). Referring parent's tuition must be \$120 or more per week.
