Law – is usually defined as a "rule of action". It is properly a precept or command coming from a superior authority, which an inferior is bound to obey. An inward principle of action, good (function) or evil (dysfunction).

Wuest Commentary

I see a power to legislate, of a different kind (different from the law of Jehovah) which asserts itself in my members, making war on the law of my mind. The law of my mind is identical with the law of Jehovah. Paul does not see in his nature two normal modes in which certain forces operate: he see's two authorities saying to him, do this, and the higher succumbing to the lower. As the lower prevails, it leads him captive to the law of sin.

Jammison-Faucet-Brown Commentary

When the apostle says he "sees" the one of these principles "warring against" the other, and "bringing him into captivity" to itself, he is not referring to any actual rebellion going on within him while he was writing, or to any captivity to his own lusts then existing. He is simply describing the two conflicting principles, and

pointing out what is the inherent property of each to aim at bringing about.

When the apostle describes himself as "brought into captivity" by the triumph of the sinful principle of his nature, he clearly speaks in the person of a renewed man. Men do not feel themselves to be in captivity in the territories of their own sovereign and associated with their own friends, breathing a congenial atmosphere, and acting quite spontaneously. But here the apostle describes himself, when drawn under the power of his sinful nature, as forcibly seized and reluctantly dragged to his enemy's camp, from which he would gladly make his escape. This ought to settle the question, whether he is here speaking as a regenerate man or the reverse.

When the Lord makes plain to the man the width and depth of *his instructions*, he needs a "renewing of the *mind*" (Rom 12:2) if he is to say with truth, "I *delight* in the Law;" verse 22, "I myself with my mind serve it."

John Gill Commentary

"By the law of his mind" – The law of Jehovah which he delighted in and served with his mind. By a renewed nature (mind – Romans 12:2). It is the governing principle, which reigns, and will reign in every regenerate person, unto eternal life. The law of Sin opposes it. It is contrary to it, lusts against it, wars against it, and commits acts of hostility against it. The state of a regenerate person is a warfare, they have many enemies to combat, as Satan and the world. Those of their own household, within themselves (their minds). The will of rebellion and the will of Jehovah combating together. True is the saying of the Jews: As long as the righteous live, they are at war with the corruption of their nature".

Romans 7:16

If then I do that which I would not, etc. - Knowing that the law (instruction) of Jehovah condemns it, and that therefore it must be evil (dysfunction). I consent unto the law of Jehovah; I show by this circumstance that I acknowledge the law to be good.
