Cover officer notifies Comms of suspect and weapon information, calls for additional resources. Contact officer is calm and able to talk in complete sentences in a clear voice. Tasks are handled based on role, such as securing the knife and maintaining lethal coverage.	
Engagement in de-escalation tactics.	Both officers are giving commands and or conflicting commands. Officers are in close distance without a plan.	One officer at a time engages in crisis communication while maintaining distance. Maximum distance is maintained until a plan is developed.	Contact officer gives 1-2 alpha commands then transitions to crisis communications. Both officers create a plan with contact officer going less-lethal while the cover officer is lethal. Contact officer uses phrases that seek to build a relationship with the subject. Contact officer is able to avoid only giving demanding statements.
