



STANDING RULES

1. Club dues shall be \$35 per year for Active members and \$20 per year for Associate members payable in compliance with PVRW bylaws. Once remitted, dues are non-refundable.
2. Charter Members shall be founding members who have paid the Charter membership fee to assist funding the new Club. As long as they are paid members they shall be recognized as “Charter Members” in the directory.
3. “A reservation made is a reservation paid” and members will be billed if they fail to attend an event they reserved for.
4. All Federation Club events are private and club has the full authority to exclude press or media. Press or media may only be present with prior approval of any speaker. Any recording of a speaker without their prior written approval is not permitted.
5. Regular monthly meeting date shall be as determined by the President trying to work with the second Wednesday of the month as a preferred date.
6. Attendance at AzFRW and NFRW events is a priority and encouraged as both a source of education and leadership training for members. The Club will endeavor to assist club members with a reimbursement of the early bird AzFRW Registration fee as Club budget and finances permit.
7. All candidates and their guests must pay for their lunches. Any campaign literature circulated or displayed at the luncheons / meetings MUST have prior approval of the President.

8. All invited speakers MUST be registered Republicans or Independents. A speaker who is registered as an Independent who upholds conservative Republican values, may be invited to speak after an approval vote by the Executive Committee.
9. PVRW may pay for the invited speaker's lunch and their one guest.
10. The President MUST approve any request by a non-active member for PVRW financial and/or membership information.
11. All luncheon guests who are NOT registered Republicans, are welcome to attend three (3) luncheons. After that they have a choice to re-register as a Republican and join PVRW or not attend any further PVRW luncheons.
12. It must be the policy of PVRW to refrain from any negative comment(s) pertaining to any Republican candidate or elected official. (President Ronald Reagan's 13th Amendment).

The Prescott Valley Republican Women Standing Rules may be amended by a majority of the votes cast by the PVRW voting members at any regular meeting.
