Prescott Valley Republican Women will award a \$1000.00 one-year higher Educational or Trade School Grant, to be applied toward the cost of tuition, fees, and books at a public or private university, college, or accredited trade school. This scholarship is to be awarded to a student attending a Prescott Valley High School.

### **Eligibility**

- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.
- Student must plan to attend a public or private university, college, or accredited trade school after high school graduation.
- Student must answer one of the essay questions.
- Student must complete the application.
- Finalist will be interviewed by Scholarship Committee members.
- Deadline for submission to Prescott Valley Republican Women is April 26th, 2024

### **Selection of Scholarship Recipient**

Prescott Valley Republican Women Scholarship Committee will review all applications and select the \$1000 scholarship winner. Winner will be notified by phone or email the week before the June 1 meeting so that they can prepare to receive their scholarship award at the 11:30 AM luncheon at The Redwoods Grill **Wednesday**, **June 5**, **2024**. The scholarships will **not** be based on financial need but on the quality of the application, written essay, and interview.

### Along with the completed application, the student must also submit:

- Official school transcript with SAT or ACT test scores (or both).
- Three (3) letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a school counselor or a teacher. No relatives.
- Verification of acceptance to a public or private university, college, or accredited trade school.
