prayer in green and orange**, which was developed from studying
the meanings of various Hebrew root words in the verses. *Please
pray this-- it's so powerful!*

Isaiah 41:14-16

**Behold, I will make you into
a new threshing sledge with sharp teeth;**
Oh Lord God, as I pray Your Word and put my trust in You to bring
my afflictions to nothing, You are making me into a new threshing
sledge with **sharp teeth!** I am your **two-edged, sharp instrument,**
appointed to **subdue and crush** my enemies.

**You shall thresh the mountains and beat them small,
And make the hills like chaff.**
As I pray Your will and Your word, Lord, You say I **trample, break,
tear, and tread down** the mountains and challenges facing me. This
prayer right now is **beating them small, pulverizing** them, and
making the hills in front of me **blow away** in the wind.

**You shall winnow them, the wind shall carry them away,
And the whirlwind shall scatter them;**
Mountains and hills facing me, in the name of Jesus and by the
authority I have as a child of Almighty God,
I **disperse** you and **cast** you away!
*The "ruwach" -- the very Spirit of the Lord Himself-- His breath, His
mind, shall **blast** you and carry you away from me now!*
My God is sending His whirlwind-- His hurricane, His tempest, His
storm-- to defend me and to **shake, break, and dash** you to pieces!

**You shall rejoice in the Lord,
And glory in the Holy One of Israel.**
Oh yes, and I now rejoice-- spin around with delight--
in the Lord, Jehovah-- the Self Existent, the Eternal.
I glory in-- shine, celebrate, and praise-- the Holy One of Israel.
