

Prayer of Authority in Jesus Christ

Father, I humble myself before You. You are God, and there is no other. You are God and there is none like You. You know the end from the beginning. (Isaiah 45)

I am Your child, and I worship You. I surrender to You now.

I come to You in need, Lord. I need Your help with (name situation). As I pray about this, I remember Your word:

It is written: Jesus lived, died, resurrected, ascended, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God, “far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come.” (Ephesians 1)

I am in Christ, for it is by faith in Him that I have been saved. It is written: God has “made us alive together with Christ...and raised us up together, and made us to sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus...” (Ephesians 2)

It is also written that You have given to Your disciples authority over all the power of the enemy (Luke 10:19).

So, it is from that position of authority in Christ that I now pray.

(Tell Him your situation. Yes, He knows it already, but He wants you to share your heart with Him in the midst of it.)

(Now let Him know what you desire. Make your requests be known.)

Thank You that You have seated me with You, Jesus, and I am praying from a position of authority over all the enemy. In Jesus’ name, I command all forces of evil to be removed from me and all those involved in this situation. (Name the specific sin out loud-- like hatred, greed, jealousy, rage, dissention, lust, etc.—and tell it to be removed in Jesus’ name. Our battle is not against flesh and blood but against powers and principalities. (Ephesians 6) Name the powers and command them to bow down at the feet of Jesus.)

“At the name of Jesus every knee will bow, above the earth, of those on the earth, and of those under the earth; and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.” (Philippians 2:10-11) Amen!
