

## **Out For Delivery**

The topic of healing was a focus in my Women's Bible Study this month. *The outcome of the study was powerful, and it must be shared.*It can be likened to the idea of a gift that's out for delivery.

Let's start with Matthew 8:16-17.

When evening had come, they brought to Him (Jesus) many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses."

Jesus cast out spirits with a word. He healed all who were sick. Why?

To fulfill the word of God spoken through Isaiah almost 700 years prior.

And what exactly had Isaiah documented hundreds of years before Jesus walked the earth in human form? Here it is, in all its glory.

"Surely He has borne our griefs (sicknesses, weaknesses, and distresses) and carried our sorrows and pains [of punishment], yet we [ignorantly] considered Him stricken, smitten, and afflicted by God [as if with leprosy].

But He was wounded for our transgressions,
He was bruised for our guilt and iniquities;
the chastisement [needful to obtain] peace and well-being for us
was upon Him, and with the stripes [that wounded] Him we are
healed and made whole."

Isaiah 53:4-5 (Amplified Bible)

Hold on a minute. Let's pause to play a little Q & A.

Q: To whom is Isaiah referring in these verses?
A: Jesus, the Lamb of God who **would come** to take away the sins of the world.

Q: What is being foretold of Jesus?

A: That He **would** take upon Himself our griefs, sicknesses, weaknesses, distresses, sorrows, pains, punishment, afflictions, wounds, transgressions, bruises, guilt, iniquities...

Q: For whom did Jesus do this?

A: Anyone who places their trust in Him, believes He is the Savior of the world, repents, and receives His free gift of eternal life.

How can this be possible?

Did you notice the verb tenses in Isaiah 53?

(In case you didn't, please scroll up and reread.

The verbs are in **bold**.)

Jesus **was** wounded, **was** bruised... and by His stripes we **are** healed. Are you getting it yet?

To sum it up,

hundreds of years **before** Jesus walked the earth in human form, and thousands of years **before** you and I came to be, He **was** (wounded, bruised) ...so that we **are** (healed).

This is called a brain twister. A mind blower. Yet, it is more real than reality itself.

God extends Himself outside time, and His reality is simply supernatural. It's other-worldly, and it is awesome.

Jesus walked amongst us, casting out evil and healing sicknesses... so that it would be fulfilled what God ordained centuries prior: 'He bore our sicknesses...By His stripes, we **are** healed.'

Your healing is a magnificent package, a free gift, sent directly to you by our Heavenly Father.

And there's more!

Check out the Hebrew root word for our English word, healed. The Hebrew word is rapha, and here is its meaning:

לְּבָּה raphâ', raw-faw'; or רְּבָּה raphâh: to mend (by stitching), i.e. (figuratively) to cure: cure, (cause to) heal, physician, repair, × thoroughly, make whole.

Jesus took upon Himself all our sin. We surrender to Him as our Lord and Savior, and by His crucifixion and resurrection,

we are rapha:

Healed.

Mended.

Cured.

Repaired.

Thoroughly.

Made whole.

What a gift.

# Did you know that one of the Lord's titles is Jehovah Rapha? This name of His literally means, The Lord who Heals You. (Exodus 15:26)

Because of Jehovah Rapha, who bore all our sin, we are now rapha, bearing His very name.

### **CHALLENGE**

1 Peter 2:24 echoes Isaiah 53, saying of Jesus,

"...who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you **were** healed."

How cool is that.

The verses **before** the crucifixion say we **are** healed. The verses **after** Jesus died, resurrected, and ascended say we **were** healed.

Jesus was, that we are; Jesus did, that we were.

There's no way around it-- if you're born again and your Lord and Savior is Jesus Christ, then you've been given a big, beautiful, free gift: *you* are healed.

That's a fact, and I believe the Holy Spirit is challenging us to align our thoughts and words with this truth.

Dare we no longer say,

"I'm not healed yet," or "It didn't work," or "I've been overlooked," and instead proclaim,

"I *am* healed by the stripes of Jesus!" ...even as we await seeing and feeling this reality?

Hang in there with me. I'm only going to challenge you to the extent that the Lord has challenged me. And for years He has challenged me to continue walking in greater heights and depths of His truth in all this.

At this point, you may be wondering,

"How can we say we are healed,
when we still feel sickness and pain in our bodies?

How do we believe we are healed,
when the x-ray still shows an abnormal growth
or the blood test comes back positive...again?"

I've wrestled with these questions myself.
They are worthy of being asked.
And answered.
As long as we don't waver from the truth in God's Word.
After all, He's the One who created our bodies,
and He's the One who has granted our healing.

Throughout my life in Christ, I've experienced what seems to be every scenario when it comes to healing: some healing has manifested immediately, some has appeared gradually, and, as of this writing, some evidence of healing has yet to be revealed. Some of you reading this (along with I, who am writing it) are currently struggling through the difficult diagnosis of someone dear-- even one who is a passionate Jesus-follower. Others of you are mourning the recent death of a loved one, after having believed wholeheartedly in their complete, revealed healing.

How do we reconcile this?

#### I realize life is complex and messy. This writing isn't intended to ignore that.

There are many other Scriptures on healing beyond what is included here. I pray the Holy Spirit speaks comfort and encouragement in the way each of us needs to hear it today.

In the midst of the mystery, it's important to stick to the Word of God, while keeping at the forefront of our minds the supernatural, other-worldly, awesome nature of God's reality.

Remember, His ways and thoughts are higher than ours. (Isaiah 55) As high as the heavens are above the earth, so are His ways above ours.

His economy is one of faith. Not sight.

This can be hard for us to wrap our heads around, but the Lord has described for us what faith is:

Faith is the substance of things hoped for and the evidence of things unseen. (Hebrews 11:1) If you don't need to hope for something anymore, and you can see evidence of it, then you don't need faith. *Inherent to having faith is it being directed towards something unseen.* 

We believe by faith that we are saved, yes? Then we shall believe by faith that we are healed. This is the Word of God. Yes?

For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.

Ephesians 2:8-9

May I share something one of the women in our Bible study said after this teaching?

"I heard a good analogy for when we wait for healing to manifest:

It is like buying something on Amazon.

You buy it, you see that it's shipped,
and you are waiting expectantly for it to arrive."

Isn't this marvelous?

How many times have we put an item in our online cart, clicked the order button, paid with the card on file or Paypal, and then... waited for days until our package arrives?

We **know** it's fully paid for.
We **know** we own it.
We **know** it's ours.
We're **assured** of this without thinking,
even though the box has yet to appear on our doorstep,

Did you know this principle is in the Scriptures as well? Daniel 10 documents how Daniel fasted and prayed for 21 days. On day 21, an angel came to him and said that his prayers had been heard from day 1, but the delivery of his answer was held up because of the fierce spiritual battle between the forces of evil and good.

I wonder what kind of spiritual battle is taking place right now, as you ask for the manifestation of the healing you know you have in Christ.

Whether your wait has been days, weeks or years, please don't stop believing and praying the Word of God.

The spiritual battle is still fierce, and we are in the middle of it. (Ephesians 6)

As with your salvation, your healing is a gift to you, dear believer. Not only that, but it's free!

Oh, it was definitely purchased.

It's been paid for in full, by Jesus, who paid the highest price.

All the more reason to take and receive it.

It may be in transit, but it's signed, sealed, and...out for delivery. Expect it, look for it, believe it.
It's a free gift, and it's yours.
