PATIENCE

Misbehavior is an expression of unmet needs. We tend to believe that behavior is either good or bad, acceptable or unacceptable. This misconception creates a lot of unnecessary difficulty for children and can create a parenting blind spot. Children do not have the same understanding and skills that most adults do because they are still developing. And just like adults, children need to be taught problem-solving, conflict resolution, and social skills. Positive parenting doesn't mean your child won't ever express negative emotions or misbehave. It does not mean you're expected not to make mistakes while parenting. Be patient with your children and with yourself.

MONETARY DONATIONS






