GUIDELINES AND BEST PRACTICES

1. Entries containing nudity, sexually explicit content, or any form of lewd imagery WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Keep the challenge family-friendly and respectful.
2. Photos should NOT depict or promote violence, discrimination, hate speech, or any content that may be offensive, discriminatory, or harmful towards individuals or groups.
3. All submitted photos must be the ORIGINAL WORK of the participants. Do not use stock images or images taken by others.
4. Appropriate Subjects: Participants should refrain from photographing children without proper consent from their parents or legal guardians. If photographing children, ensure it is done in a responsible and ethical manner, with appropriate permissions obtained.
5. Get creative and think outside the box when documenting the icons in your photos! Experiment with different techniques, and showcase your unique perspective.
