GUIDELINES AND BEST PRACTICES

- 1. Entries containing nudity, sexually explicit content, or any form of lewd imagery WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Keep the challenge family-friendly and respectful.
- 2. Photos should NOT depict or promote violence, discrimination, hate speech, or any content that may be offensive, discriminatory, or harmful towards individuals or groups.
- 3. All submitted photos must be the ORIGINAL WORK of the participants. Do not use stock images or images taken by others.
- 4. Appropriate Subjects: Participants should refrain from photographing children without proper consent from their parents or legal guardians. If photographing children, ensure it is done in a responsible and ethical manner, with appropriate permissions obtained.
- 5. Get creative and think outside the box when documenting the icons in your photos! Experiment with different techniques, and showcase your unique perspective.
- 6. Social media posting is encouraged. Please use the following hashtags:

- 7. Your submission may be featured in the national Iconic Photo Challenge.
- 8. Multiple entries are allowed, but each entry should be unique and meet all challenge requirements.
