Message from Pastor Tim Manatt S.J.

Last fall I was asked in a survey of pastors about my goals for 2021. That was an easy question. Goal #1: Help my parishioners survive the pandemic—physically, emotionally, and spiritually. Goal #2: Have FUN together this summer, unmasked and unafraid!

Although we are making a lot of progress toward Goal #1, “vaccine hesitancy” is still an issue holding us back.

As for Goal #2, here’s what’s coming in July and August:

Summer Activities

- **Saturday, July 3:** Bike ride for kids ages 7-12. Starting from the lighthouse under the Hoan Bridge, we’ll ride along Lake Michigan to Bradford Beach with a surprise activity halfway.

- **Sunday, August 8:** 12-8 p.m. Parish Festival on 4th Street between Bruce and Pierce.
