The Epiphany of the Lord

The Bible does not mention the exact number of wise men, nor does it specify their names. We only know that they came from the East. Their names-- Melchor, Gaspar, Balthazar-- come to us by way of Tradition. In some countries, especially in Latin

America, it is traditional on this day to give gifts to children, commemorating the gifts that the wise men brought to baby Jesus according to the Gospel of Matthew (Mt. 2:1-12).

The parishes are happy to offer an aguinaldo/bolo/candy bag for all kids and teenagers at the end of all Masses on January 7th.






