Message from Fr. Rick Abert, S.J.

Advent again, Advent always.

There is a word that speaks to the essential reality of human beings, and while we might not talk about it much, it rests in the heart of us all. The word is "belonging." It is arguably the most significant human reality that calls us to know who we are; to be human is to belong; to be fully human is to "long to be" connected to others and connected to the earth we make our home. We are created by a God whose love arrives at our heart always in the form of God's Son, Jesus Christ. Jesus desires to belong to us as one who enters those places in our lives where healing, courage, strength and transformation need to be real for us. Our deep human longing not to be alone in life's struggles is the call that God is always attuned to and to which God's Spirit is always ready to find us and fill us. We have often heard that God's Spirit, a Spirit of peace and mission, is the "belonging link" between us and God, us and one another.

The very first Monday of Advent sets a very hopeful tone for us. Isaiah the prophet offers us the image of "all nations of the world" *streaming together* to the Lord's mountain, the place of God's teaching what it means to be a people whose hearts long to be connected; a people who "long to belong" so intimately as to allow differences of race, color, political rivalry, negative history slide into the past. In Advent we have another opportunity to recognize that we are all part of becoming God's longing to be received in us so that we might know again a hope that will make belonging to one another real again, and always.
