Message from Pastor Tim Manatt, S.J.

St Ignatius of Loyola, the founder of the Jesuit Order to which all your priests at Guadalupe/St Patrick's belong, died on July 31, 1556. That's why Jesuit parishes and schools around the world promote July as the "Month of St Ignatius." As in previous years, the preaching at masses on Sundays will have a connection to some aspect of the spirituality of Ignatius. In addition, there will be a parish-sponsored activity every weekend.
