The artists will be judged in the following groups: Elementary/Middle/High School.

There will be special prizes and awards in four age categories. Monetary Awards

There are no entry fees to compete

- One artwork per participant is allowed
- 3D and 2D artwork allowed
- Artwork must be submitted suitable for gallery hanging (**wired and framed**)
- Size Limit – 20 inches on any side (including frame)
- Entry forms to be completed in duplicate - One form will be attached to back of work
- Work must be original - Copies, giclée's or reprints will not be eligible to win awards.
- Teachers and parents will be notified of award winning students

Artwork drop-off: Saturday, March 2, 11 am – 4 pm

Artwork pick-up: Friday April 5, 11 am – 5 pm

Reception: Saturday, March 9, 3 pm – 5 pm (**Awards at 3:30 pm**)
