



ALL of our major monthly events (Art Take-in, Judging, Demo, and Gallery Reception) will take place between the 1st Saturday Take-in and the 2nd Saturday Reception. This gives the Gallery time to build momentum for the rest of the month to focus on Sales.

So, your DEMO will be in SHOW WEEK. This streamlining of the schedule means that Demo will never take place after the Art Reception (no more 2nd Thursday's). This new schedule puts our DEMO right where it should be smack dab in the middle of SHOW WEEK!

We find that serious Art Collectors WANT TO KNOW MORE. They want to understand WHO the artist really is, where they come from, how they FEEL about their art, and so much more! We find that we get a lot more social media "hits" (traction and engagement) by using photos, video, audio, interviews, and storytelling in our descriptions of art. People don't just want to see a pretty picture. They want to know WHY you painted it, your personal history, and how your artwork impacts the world!

Therefore, in the future when you submit artwork for 1st Saturday Take-in, PLEASE take the time to also send us a good photo (jpg) of the art, and include with it a small paragraph about the piece or yourself as an artist.
