

OUTDOOR ROTATION

There are many ways to get your Artwork out into the world! We want to help with that. Along with the 12 gallery exhibitions we host per year, we also do Rotations in various restaurants, bars, and event spaces in town. You provide the artwork (no Take-in Submission Fee, this is totally FREE to members); we help facilitate the venue. Rotations can be various lengths of time: one month at minimum, a year at maximum. Any sales made from the Rotation location go through the gallery with the usual 15% commission going to EAA. Our other Rotation locations include:

Our newest Rotation is a single painting one! You can have a painting on the easel out in front advertising the gallery for one month. This opportunity does not cost you anything, no submission Take-in fee. Any 2D medium; minimum size 12" x 12", maximum size 36" x 36".

Scholarship Awards

Graduating seniors who represent many of the Escondido high schools and have met the deadline date of March 4th for drop off of all materials and artwork, will be judged on March 8th and winners selected by our judges. Judging the competition this year will be Tokeli Baker and Pat Hunter. Awards totaling \$1,000 will be made through the generous support of Dan Forster and Heather Moe of Design Moe Kitchen & Bath, in the following amounts: \$500 for First Place; \$250 for Second Place; \$150 for Third Place; and two Honorable Mention awards in the amount of \$50 each.

All artwork will remain on exhibit in the gallery for the month of March. A reception and award ceremony will take place at the Artists Gallery on Saturday, March 11, 2023 from 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m., with awards being presented at 5:00 p.m. Refreshments will be served.


