

Awards were presented to the following outstanding young artists as follows: First Place (\$500) to Allison Atkinson, Escondido H.S.; 2nd Place (\$250) to Frida Aguilar, Escondido H.S.; 3rd Place (\$150) to Jordan Stephens, Escondido Charter H.S.; Honorable Mention awards (\$50 each) to Evany Huerta, Valley H.S. and Megan Payne, Calvin Christian H.S. Winners also received a free two-year membership in the EAA.

Judging the competition this year were Tokeli Baker, EAA President, and Pat Hunter, Marketing Director, who made their selections from among 27 pieces of artwork representing six participating Escondido high schools. Award money to fund the Visual Arts Scholarship Program this year was again provided through the generous sponsorship of Design Moe Kitchen & Bath of Escondido. All student artwork will remain on exhibit at the Artists Gallery through the end of March.

## GLOBAL ROOTS MURAL UNVEILING




