Monty Montgomery

Monty Montgomery began exhibiting his work professionally in 1999. Born and raised in Virginia, Montgomery loved straight lines and bright colors at a very young age. He was influenced by his mother who was a kindergarten teacher and his father's craftsmanship. Early memories of creating in the shop beside his father along with crayons and coloring books on the kitchen table guided by his mother left an impression that reflects in his work to this day.

In his teen years Monty discovered that he connected to the world a bit differently; the realization that he was profoundly absorbing emotional and physical energy from every experience in his path led him to interpret that energy and channel it into unique creative expressions. In his junior year at Longwood University he launched Cilli Original Designs and began spreading his word through clothing, paintings, poetry, stickers and culture.

After earning his BFA from Longwood University in 1998, he took his first graphic design-based job with U.S. Graphics in Virginia Beach, VA. In 1999, he made the move to Charlottesville, VA to work for Musictoday.com while simultaneously designing projects in the music/surf/skate industries as well as operating and curating C.O.D. Gallery & Studios on the Downtown Mall in "C-VILLE". After several great years in Virginia, he made the move to Boston, MA. in 2006 to expand his vision in a major city.

In 2008, Montgomery launched the next chapter of his career by making the move to San Diego, California. Monty then spent 2019/2020 in Brooklyn, New York and Santa Fe, New Mexico before hitting the road in 2021 for projects across the USA. In 2022, Monty made the decision to permanently base his life and studios in sunny San Diego, California and the deep woods of Bumpass, Virginia. In recent years he has begun focusing on collaborative projects with various artists California Center for the Arts Museum which is located at 340 N. Escondido Blvd, Escondido.

WINNER VOLUNTEER OF THE MONTH AWARD JENNIFER WALLACE

What is your Full name? Jennifer June Wallace

Where were you born?

I was born in Framingham, Massachusetts, and grew up on the East Coast, enjoying cold, snowy winters, and beautiful fall trees!

What do you love about the city you live in?

Escondido is a great eclectic mix of people, ethnicities, and culture. Being different is what makes us stand out! I love the rolling hills and their beauty! There is more of a small town feel, to me, which is inviting- and yet I believe there is so much opportunity and room to grow!



Why do you volunteer with the EAA?

I volunteer with EAA because of the people! It's the people of EAA that make it work, and make it a great community to be a part of! I enjoy being a part of a community that appreciates art like I do, and sees its value!

What is your art background?

I have always loved art, whether I was entering coloring contests as a child, creating mixed media collages in my teens, painting ceramics, as my mother taught classes, or taking art class in high school and college. When younger, although I enjoyed art, I always questioned the usefulness and meaning of the pursuit of it. After winning a drawing contest in college for art classes, I ended up changing course the next semester, and not pursuing art. I now wish I had pursued art at a younger age, as there is so much I wish I knew more about. I now realize just how meaningful and important art is. To me, not only is it a form of self-expression, representing who you are, and what makes you uniquely you, it is our unique voice that we get to share with others! I believe we are made in the image of our Creator, and that He is the ultimate artist! Think about how just going outside, hearing the birds sing, feeling a cool breeze across your face, or watching an amazing sunset, makes you feel; the colors speak to your soul, and it can bring peace and rest to your being! (Psalm 19 speaks of this exact thing!) To me, that is the "voice" of our Creator, revealing himself to us daily! It is my hearts' desire to use my voice (my art) to inspire and encourage! I am thankful for the time I have now, to pursue art.

If you are an artist what is your preferred medium and why?

My preferred mediums are watercolor and photography. I really enjoy watercolor, for the looseness of it, and the way the colors blend so easily, although that can also make it hard to control! (it helps me to let go, and remind myself that it doesn't have to be perfect!) Sometimes the best results are those unexpected 'mistakes' or "happy little accidents", as Bob Ross liked to say!) And to me, photography is a way to share what you see, and how you perceive something, to those around you. I enjoy photographing from different perspectives, whether a different angle, or macro. I like the saying, "Afterall, what you see, depends on the lense through which you are looking." In other words, how we perceive something, is dependent upon our own perspective, life experiences, and filters- so although we might be looking at the same thing, we may perceive it very differently.

Who is your favorite artist, past or present and why?

I have always loved Monet- I once saw his original paintings in the Boston Museum of Art, and it was mesmerizing! What was so amazing, was to get up close to his paintings- it looks as if it is just tons of random color and brush strokes, but when you step back for a different viewpoint- it all becomes clear! I could have sat there for hours staring at them.

Do you have a hobby other than art?

I love to bake! I find it relaxing and a great way to spend my down time. I'm always looking for takers to eat my baking, often sending it to work with my husband, which has won him some "brownie" points! :) (however, I really dislike the dishes it creates!)

What is something interesting about you that others might not know?

I enjoy playing the piano, although I am no Mozart! I still like to sit down and try to write some new tunes, even




FRIEND AND TEACHER TO EAA, IGOR KOUTSENKO, HONORED BY ARTWALK SAN DIEGO


