




1. Register as a vendor in our system

<u>Follow this link to start the process</u>. If you have already received checks from another CTCARES program, you will still need to register but will have a modified process.

Keep in mind that:

- You need to register using the email address on file for your specific license.
- As part of the process, you'll complete an IRS form W-9, since your program i this is taxable income.
- If you're not sure what kind of business you have, the IRS has <u>additional inforfilling out your W-9</u> that will help. You can also call the please contact <u>Womer Development Council</u> at <u>203-751-9550</u>.

2. Apply for the subsidy





CTCARES for Child Care Businesses is here to support your child care program. Funds are now available to pay for a variety of items you need to operate during COVID-19 and recovery. Early childhood programs are similar yet different. You decide what you will use.

EXPENSE KICKSTART:

SUPPLY SUBSIDY:

HEALTH TRAINING SUBSIDY

Expands Thrive to coordinate First Aid / CPR / medical admin training to programs statewide.

BACKGROUND CHECK SUBSIDY:

Covers the cost for those new to hire or expiring.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT:

Free online training via Registry account, and scholarship for credit and degree coursework

BUSINESS SUPPORT:

Group and individualized business coaching and training, funding application support, and incentives.

PROGRAM

QUALITY SUPPORTS: Statewide quality improvement support via Accreditation Quality Initiative Supports (AQIS) for centers, and Staffed Family Child Care Networks
