- Conducted our first ever virtual annual meeting
- Conducted our first ever online/electronic election of new board members
- Conducted several virtual Board of Director meetings
- Educational webinar featuring Dr. Frank Rossi where attendees could earn CEU's through the GCSAA for Class A and Certification
- Began a comprehensive communication program and sent out many member communications keeping everyone informed
- Played a key role in assisting with the creation and development of the Arizona Alliance for Golf
- In May we concluded our St. Mary's Food Bank Drive initiated by Rory Van Poucke, Gabe Towers and Carmella and collected over 1500 lbs. of food & dry goods and raised over \$1,450.00 to be given to St. Mary's Food & Fund Drive. - Participated in a large number of meetings with regulatory agencies including the Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR), Department of Agriculture, ADEQ, amongst others.
- Initiated and participated in a number of virtual calls with U.S. Senators and Congressmen and Women to continue to educate high level decision makers in the State and Washington DC about the facts about golfs impact on the Arizona economy.
- Held our first ever wildlife photo contest and received over 100 photos. A panel of former Cactus and Pine officers and other key industry people made up a team of judges who selected the winners who received congratulation gift cards. With these photos, we produced our 1st Calendar for 2021!

- Initiated and participated in a community service project to overseed the field and renovate the pitcher's mound and home plate areas on the baseball field at Mountain View High School in Mesa, AZ in honor of past Cactus & Pine GCSA Board President Gregg Thomas who passed away in September. We had over 26 Cactus and Pine members and Affiliates participate in this service project
