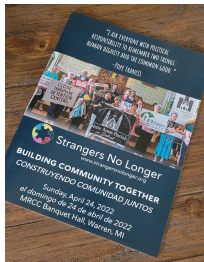

Strangers No Longer has accomplished a lot--here are some highlights:

- SNL Immigrant Circles revised our Platform for Dignity in 2023 to guide our statewide efforts for a more welcoming community.
- We held Assemblies for Human Dignity in Detroit and Traverse City in 2023. In Traverse City, the focus was on securing mental health resources. In Detroit, the focus was on eliminating wage theft and the continuing the advocacy for driver's licenses.
- Our Advocacy team continues to work to get the Drive Safe bills passed and is starting work on bills that will combat wage theft. Another Advocacy Day in Lansing is being planned for April 23rd.
- We continue to expand our reach in the upper Lower Peninsula of Michigan, including Traverse City, Ionia, and Saginaw.
- 12 Catholic High Schools participate in SNL and are planning a trip to the border this summer.
