As we began processing and seeking God's guidance about His new vision for our ministry, the Lord connected us with Brent and Tim Teague (missionaries to West Africa). Through much prayer, multiple conversations, and a productive ministry trip to Africa; God heavily impressed on our hearts and spirits that He is sending us to Côte d'Ivoire, West Africa. Côte d'Ivoire is situated on the southern bulge of West Africa between Liberia and Ghana. It is estimated that within the next 10 years over half of the population of the continent of Africa will be living in only ten cities.

Ministry in Côte d'Ivoire

To ascertain the place where God is sending us, we traveled to Abidjan, Côte d'Ivoire for two weeks of ministry. It was a productive trip of serving and building relationships with the people and the church leaders. We had the opportunity to teach in the villages, build a tabernacle, and minister in several churches. God was moving in people's hearts. During our services, 24 people received Christ as their Lord and Savior! Joy and peace resonate in our spirit as God clearly confirmed that Côte d'Ivoire is our new assignment!

Abidjan (*where we will be serving*) is one of those cities. Approximately 26 million people in Côte d'Ivoire come mostly from five principal ethnic groups. Although more than 60 dialects are spoken in the country, French is the official language taught in the schools. Many of the people are animists (estimated as high as 63 percent), or fetish worshippers. One-fourth of the population is Muslim. A scant 7.6 percent of the population is Protestant. Fortunately, religious freedom makes it possible for us to minister freely.

We will return to the United States and begin the itineration process in January 2020. Once we have raised our budget, we will leave for Abidjan, Côte d'Ivoire. Our primary ministry will be teaching student pastors in the Bible Schools and lay leaders in the villages. We will also be helping to plant an International church and building tabernacles in different villages. We will be doing evangelism through crusades, the Jesus movie, and one-on-one meetings.

God spoke to Paul and changed his direction and ministry. In a similar way, God has spoken to us and has given us a new assignment as we embark on our second term of serving Him. We are excited to see what God will do through us as we continue to walk in obedience to His call.
