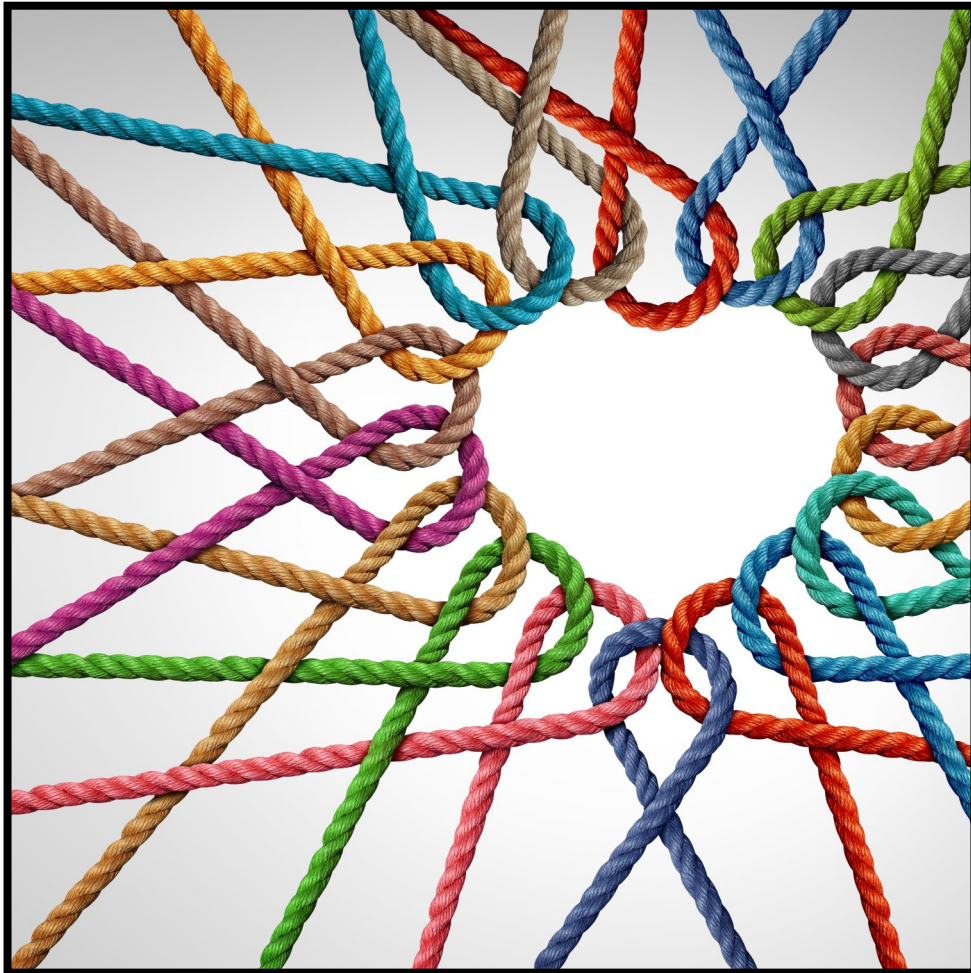

Thanks to all of the 6k participants we raised **\$3,605** (clean water for 72 people).

Almost 40 walkers, strollers, joggers and runners completed the 6k in Moon Valley, San Diego and northern Arizona last Saturday. Since 2000, 2.1 billion people have gained access to clean water - so we believe it's possible to end the global water crisis in our lifetimes.

When communities have reliable access to clean water, it transforms every aspect of their lives. Better health, education, and economic opportunities flow from clean water.

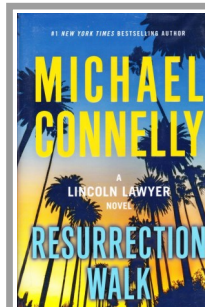

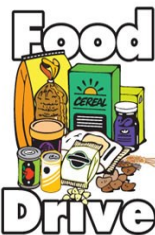
