

Arts Camp 2025 - Class Description/overview

Jr Campers K-2nd Grade -

Arts - Kaleidoscope, Sensory bottle, Tissue paper/salt picture, Ribbon Rings

Song and Dance - Learn Musical songs and simple dance moves for production

Story Time - Stories and time in the new Godly Play room

Sign Language - Learn sign language to go with musical song

Sr Campers 3rd -10th Grade-

Note: there are 5 sessions (classes) for Sr Campers. Campers will rank their top 7 choices, which we will try to hard to honor, the early you register, the better chance of getting favorite classes.

Set Design - Help paint and design set scenery

Sound Booth* - Learn how the sound booth works and what it takes to support services

Journalism* - work together to create a camp newsletter.

Photography* - Learn how to take candid shots to be used in a PowerPoint for a camp week overview

Percussion - Be part of the "Stomp" drumline and more

Guitar* - explore how to play a simple song on a guitar.

Chimes/Bells - Learn how to properly handle a bell and perform a song

Boom Whackers - Learn how to play a "tuned" tube and perform a song.

Dance - Learn and perform a dance number

Woodworking - Learn some basic woodworking skills while making a candy dispenser

Polymer Clay - Make a clay pen and trinket box using polymer clay

Cake Decorating - Learn basic decorating skills and make cupcakes to share.

Candy Making - Learn how to create some delicious candy.

Scrapbook - Bring 20 photos or memorabilia and design some scrapbook pages

Lotion and Potions -Learn how to pamper yourself by making bath bombs, sugar scrub, lip balm, a candle and soap,

Mural Painting* - Help create a mural for the new Godly Play room

Mosaic - Help create a mosaic of the story of Zaccheaus

Resin and Bead Jewelry - Create/make a ring, bracelet and necklace with resin and beads

Banner Making -Create a Church and a personal banner

Watercolor painting - Learn some tricks while creating a watercolor masterpiece

Acrylic Painting - Create a picture while learning some painting techniques.

Batik Painting - create a painted banner using wax as a medium

Loom Knitting - Learn to use a Loom to knit a hat

Board Game Design* - Explore and create a board game

Cartooning - Learn how to create a story board and characters

Tissue Paper Lanterns - Create and design a tissue lantern

Paper Making - Learn how to recycle used paper to create a paper cover for a journal

Milagro Cross* - Explore your Blessing and prayers for your gratitude and hopes using symbols to be nailed to a cross while journaling.

Stamping Class - Learn some different stamping techniques while creating cards and book and Bible markers, so to be used as gift for others.
