

COME, JOIN THE DANCE OF TRINITY

Come, join the dance of Trinity, before all worlds begun – the interweaving of the Three: the Father, Spirit, Son.

The universe of space and time did not arise by chance, but as the Three, in love and hope, made room within their dance.

Come, see the face of Trinity, new-born in Bethlehem; then bloodied by a crown of thorns outside Jerusalem. The dance of Trinity is meant for human flesh and bone; when fear confines the dance in death, God rolls away the stone.

Come, speak aloud of Trinity, as wind and tongues of flame set people free at Pentecost to tell the Savior's name. We know the yoke of sin and death, our necks have worn it smooth; go tell the world of weight and woe that we are free to move!

* THE NICENE CREED

People of God, what do you believe?

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen.

We believe in one Lord, Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, eternally begotten of the Father, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, of one Being with the Father.
