Heaven and earth are full of your glory, hosanna in the highest!

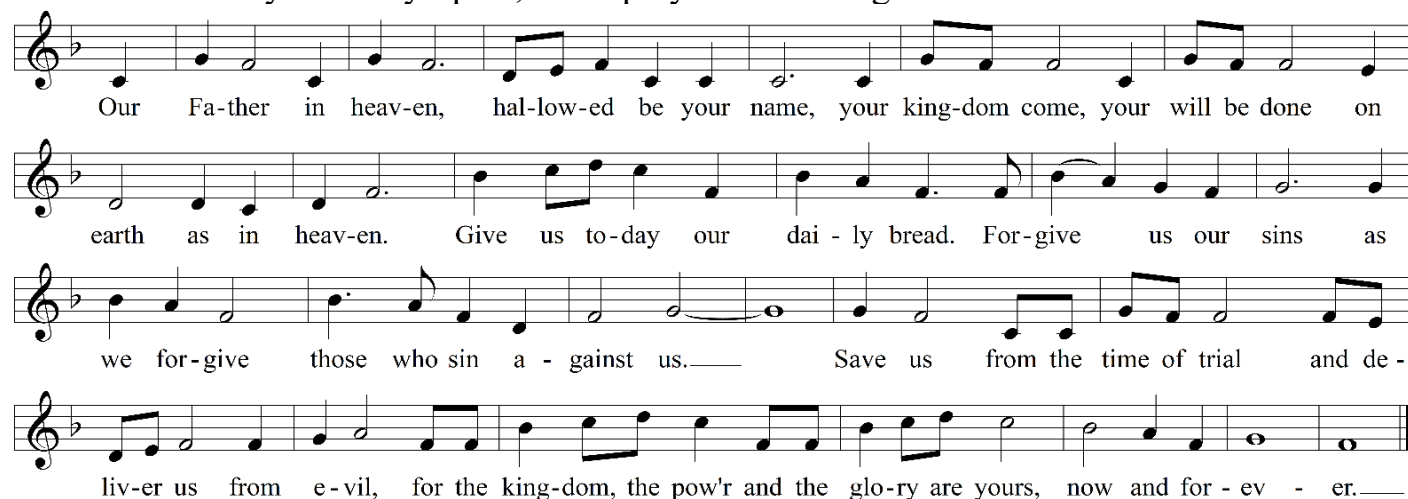
Blest is he who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!

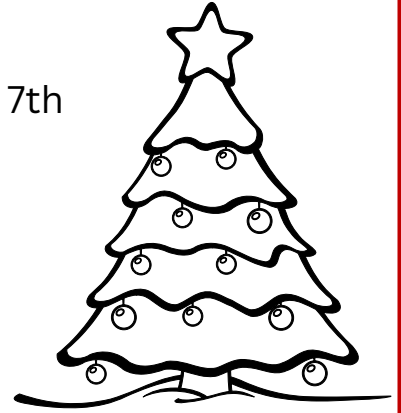

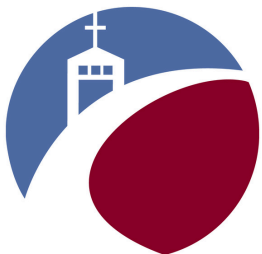
