**for the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours, now and forever.**



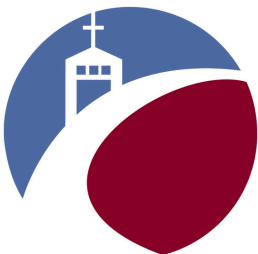
