


The Joy Circle meets the first Tuesday of each month from 9:30-11am. The lessons are independent.


A blessed Happy New Year to all!

Dear Friends:

On behalf of the West Valley Community Food Pantry, we would like to thank you for your very generous donation of \$1,020 on November 21, 2024. This donation will allow us to continue to serve those in need. As grocery prices and needs rise, we depend even more on donations from our sister congregations. Everyone at the food pantry is a volunteer so the money donated goes for food. We sincerely appreciate your generosity and support!

During 2024, we continued to see a substantial increase in the number of individuals and families facing emergency situations and were in need of a food box. We served 29,788 clients in 2024 during our normal working hours which shows the constant need for service. This is an increase of 6.397 clients over last year. In November of 2024, we provided 54 families with food to prepare the traditional Thanksgiving dinner.

It is gifts of food, funds, and other donations that make our emergency food pantry possible. We depend totally on donations. You have made a difference in the lives of many!



Truckers - The MVPs of the Thrift Shop

When the Lutheran Thrift Shop first opened, donations were picked up and furniture purchases delivered by volunteers using their own pick-up trucks. Having the ability to pick up and deliver large items was crucial to the shop's initial success and continues to be a major component of our daily operation and very important to our customers.

Over the years, business has steadily increased and the shop kept up with a seven-passenger 14' box truck which is a major part of the shop's successful business plan. Picking up donations and delivering in the west valley keeps the truck rolling several days a week. The need for able-bodied men and women to help on the truck always exists and is a constant struggle for management.

Would you make a good trucker? Are you a friendly, outgoing person who would make a good impression for the shop with our donors and customers? No special driver's license required and we have all the necessary equipment to safely handle furniture. We have also implemented "volunteer friendly" expectations for our truck crew; no sofa-sleepers & no stairs!
