The power of a single glow to dispel darkness; the capacity of a single spark to create warmth; the immense energy in a single drop of sunlight.


It's a simple logic, this message you speak: the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness cannot overcome it;

SCRIPTURE LESSON Matthew 4:12-23

Now when Jesus heard that John had been arrested, he withdrew to Galilee. He left Nazareth and made his home in Capernaum by the sea, in the territory of Zebulun and Naphtali, so that what had been spoken through the prophet Isaiah might be fulfilled: "Land of Zebulun, land of Naphtali, on the road by the sea, across the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles— the people who sat in darkness have seen a great light, and for those who sat in the region and shadow of death light has dawned." From that time Jesus began to proclaim, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near."







