

June Mission of the Month




It is time to declutter! Fill your trunk and bring your unwanted treasures to give away at our second Junk in the Trunk Event, June 2nd, 11am to 12pm.

Consistory Update



For the month of May, The Advocacy and Global Mission committee chose World Central Kitchen to receive \$500



not-for-profit, governmental organization that provides food relief. It Central was founded in 2010 by Spanish American chef and

restaurateur José Andrés following the earthquake in Haiti, and has subsequently responded to Hurricane

Harvey, the 2018 lower Puna eruption, 2023 Turkey-Syria earthquakes, and the ongoing Gaza humanitarian crisis.

Volunteers are always needed to start providing meals, as quickly as possible, to people impacted by crises. WCK's Relief Team works with professional chefs, logistics experts, local restaurants, and other established organizations.

WCK does not respond to a set list of disasters or crises. "We show up when food access has been disrupted. Our model has worked following a grocery store shooting in Buffalo, NY, a global pandemic, hurricanes, war in Ukraine, etc. We feed people - and when an emergency disrupts access to food, we will be there."
