The March Mission of the Month is Ronald McDonald House Charities of the Capital Region.

RMHC-CR has four main branches. They are the Ronald McDonald House, The Ronald McDonald Family Room, The Ronald McDonald Family Retreat at Krantz Cottage, and Helping Our Preemies Excel (HOPE). Located across the street from Albany Medical Center, The Ronald McDonald House is a "home away from home - free of charge - for families with children facing serious medical issues." The Ronald McDonald Family Room is located "steps away from the NICU." It "offers a refuge from the stress and tension of the hospital environment." While still being close to their babies, families can take a break to relax, have a snack, watch some television, or connect with other family members. The Ronald McDonald Family Retreat at Krantz Cottage is located in the Village of Lake George. Here, families of children with serious illnesses can make lasting memories without many of the worries they are typically burdened with. Their lodging is free, and they have access to a Family Support Specialist. This individual acts like a concierge, supplying them with donated activities and helping them meet their needs while enjoying their time away. HOPE is the newest program of The Ronald McDonald House Charities of the Capital Region. Approximately half of the RMHC clientele is families of premature babies in the NICU. Through HOPE, families are provided with tote bags filled with items to help families during their child's stay in the NICU.

Tenebrae Worship April 7 7 PM

Tenebrae, or "Service of Shadows," is one of the oldest traditions in the Christian church for the commemoration of the passion and death of Christ. Through scripture readings and song, the story of Christ's betrayal, trial, and crucifixion is told. As the Passion story unfolds, candles are removed symbolizing the fleeing of the disciples. The darkness deepens, until only the Christ Candle remains. This light is removed from the sanctuary representing Christ's crucifixion and death. The Light of our Church returns in glory Easter morning.


This service will also be livestreamed on Zoom. All services are recorded for later viewing on Facebook or YouTube.

Due to the somber intensity of this service, child care is provided for children 2nd grade and younger.


Church Choir
