Prompt us to seek you with our whole heart and guide us to walk in your ways, that we may carry out the vows of the covenant we share.


May our words and deeds bring life and faith to others, as we hold fast to the gift of faith.


Be with us as we worship you this day, and bless us with your light, that our time with you may be filled with grace. Amen.



SCRIPTURE LESSON Philippians 2:1-13




