The Community Reformed Church of Colonie's Quilt Group finished the season with a delivery of over 100 placemats to Shaker Place Rehabilitation and Nursing Center. This caps an amazingly productive year of finishing and delivering a total of 250 plus placemats to our neighbors in this facility.

DeRonda Daniels, their volunteer coordinator, and her staff were excited and grateful to have so many beautiful mats and plan to use them in the residents' and patients' rooms to brighten their surroundings.

It's been our pleasure and honor to serve this community of people for two years. Last year, the Quilt Group made Walker and Wheelchair bags and lap quilts for this same facility. We pray that the work we have contributed will bring a little bit of hominess to those who are no longer able to reside in their own homes.

When the group resumes in September, we will start our next project: making kids' quilts for Project Linus, a nation-wide organization that, since 1995, has delivered nearly 10 million handmade blankets and quilts to children who are seriously ill, traumatized, or in need.





Project Linus blankets go to local chapters which distribute them to charities and organizations that serve the local community. In our area, chapters serve Rensselaer, Albany, Schenectady, Schoharie, and Otsego Counties.
