
**SCRIPTURE LESSON** Matthew 4:1-11

Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil. He fasted forty days and forty nights, and afterwards he was famished. But he answered, "It is written, 'One does not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.'"
