"The Gifts of God for the People of God. Come for all things are now made ready." These words are often used as an invitation to share the loaf and the cup of Holy Communion. But in the context of stewardship, they may also be used as an invitation to reflect on God's bountiful blessings.

It is good to name the gifts, to count our blessings. It is good to be still and come to know God's mysteries. It is good to receive the gift of silence to share with a world that is weary of chaos, darkness, fear, and hopelessness.

Faithful stewards, servants of Christ, need the gift of silence to hear God's message. Where do I go? What do I do? How do I give? The voice of God is often overcome by the ringing, buzzing, faxing, booming, and shouting of the world around us. Shhh. Be still.

As you prepare for Consecration Sunday on April 26, set aside at least five minutes each day to be still and quiet. What is God saying to you in the silence? What is the commitment only you can make to share God's gifts? List the gifts and needs of your congregation and community. Name ways you can commit to generously working to meet those needs.

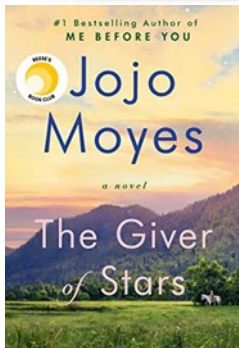
