


A proven, universal approach to screening young children in health care settings.

ABCD works to increase health and developmental screening and referral rates for all young children by integrating routine screenings into well-child visits. ABCD Coordinators work with medical professionals to increase the use of standardized screening tools and to refer children who may need follow-up for appropriate services.
