- General Items:
 - Status of uniforms Mr. Smith has touched base with FJM. Will confirm the final time and date for delivery.
 - Mr. Smith will double check the status of media releases for students. We did not get to send out pictures from the day the fire truck was here during band camp.
 - Charter buses have been reserved for the away football games at Upperman High School and Cookeville High School as well as the MTSU Band competition.
 Nami motioned to utilize funds raised by Coupon Book Sales to cover these

unanticipated costs. Jeanne Ann seconded. All members voted in favor - none opposed.

- Outstanding Band Fees
 - No update for this month as school transitions fee collection over to the Givebacks system. Mr. Smith to follow up when information is available. As of the end of June, approximately 90 of 145 enrolled students had paid band fees in full and 7 students were still awaiting confirmation of band participation.
- Mr. Smith is working on three grant applications.
 - Morgan Wallen Foundation Grant Like the grants to be a combination of music and athletics.
 - Need parent advocate
 - Mr. Smith to reach out to baseball coach to pitch joint application.
 - Grammy's Music Teacher of the Year
 - If Mr. Smith is selected in the top 10, the band program would receive \$10,000.
 - Due in December
 - Country Music Awards Music Teacher of Excellence \$5,000
 - Parent letter of recommendation
 - Administrator letter of recommendation
 - Due in February/March
 - Mr. Smith is going to contact the grant writing support personnel in the KCS office to determine if there are other opportunities.
