#### Concessions

- Jeanne Hartzog working with Tom and Patrick as a potential new co-lead next fall for inventory and ordering. Thank you!!
- Another family is considering taking on the lead position, but working through first few months of new job that has potential for heavy travel before committing, but will continue with other concessions activities.

- Need to find one or two other people to volunteer for concessions as a lead or co-leads next fall. Ideally would be 2-3 people to share the responsibility.
- Santa's Village at Farragut Christmas Parade
  - Awaiting final go / no go from the city of Farragut
  - When: Sunday, December 8
  - Needs:
    - Will require volunteers to set up, staff, cleanup and breakdown the booth
  - Will plan to sell popcorn, candy, remaining water and soft drinks, hot apple cider, and hot chocolate.
- Booster provided the meal at the Seymour competition vs. Western Carolina due to road concerns - catered by the Seymour Band Boosters.

- To Directors
  - Inquired about outstanding (Fair Share / Fees) noted in emails from directors still requesting payments.
    - Currently \$8,500 short in fair share fees.
- By-Law items (agenda item, will keep even if there's nothing to show)
  - No updates proposed.
- Vote(s) (agenda item, will keep even if there's nothing to show)
  - Sousaphone case partial purchase of three to protect on bus trip in March and others purchased across next year or two
    - Fabrication is 2-8 weeks depending on final company chosen
    - \$765 per case plus shipping (~\$928.25 per case) Still reviewing companies and types of cases that meet the criteria for stacking, have wheels and rugged
      - Questions prior to calling a vote?

- Budget
  - Looking to have discussions in person (for first meeting at minimum) between the booster board and directors to align on goals and objectives as part of the budgeting process
    - Discussed how proceeding to start earlier will permit time to work vs. being rushed prior to end of the year.
      - This will not move the final general booster vote set to be at the spring concert.
  - Discussed placing budget on website
    - Would like transparency to boosters, but not the world
    - Should we email families directly?
      - Prior to the vote the budget is issued via Booster Buzz for review and provides a way for Q&A
    - Should the budget be posted but be password protected? (Will look into)
    - Note, if the budget requires an update after the spring concert or a cost is outside the budget the by-laws requires votes at specified levels, so there is a check and balance in place currently.
