Potential Fundraising Plans

- Snap Raise
 - Online platform using emails, text messaging and social media.
 - Fundraising program gets 85% and 10% from sales through online store sale.
 - Each band student asked to provide 20 emails and 20 phone numbers of family members, friends, anyone who might be willing to support the program.
 - Campaign runs 28 days, Snap Raise does the work (driving traffic, marketing).
 - Never had a data leak, will not share or sell anyone's personal information.
