(LI-HWAP) Starts October 27

customers <u>MUST submit</u> copies of all required documentation listed below no later than <u>24 hours BEFORE</u> their appointment date and time in to the drop box located at:

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

- Most recent water/wastewater bill and water utility account numbers
- Citizenship or legal residency documentation including ID for applicant, in addition to copies of Social Security Cards (or Birth Certificates if Social Security Card is unavailable) for <u>all</u> household members (must be clear viewable copies)
- Verification of <u>all</u> household income (gross amount)- for 30 days or past 12 months (for all household members 18 yrs and older)
- OR Disability documentation (if applicable)
