

UNMH BYLAWS

Revised UNMH Bylaws have now passed by affirmative vote of the medical staff following revisions to the version presented to medical staff for vote in late 2020.

Many thanks to clinical affairs staff, and UNMH medical staff leadership, clinical department chairs, and the bylaws task force for the monumental efforts (in the midst of a significant COVID surge) needed to revise and amend the bylaws in response to initial medical staff concerns that resulted in a failure to pass with the first vote.

Once approved by UNM Hospital Board of Trustees, these bylaws will go in effect, and the Office of Clinical Affairs and UNMH Medical Staff Leadership will then begin the process of operationalizing these bylaws.

Major elements of operationalizing the bylaws will include:

- 1. reconciliation and revision of the medical staff rules and regulations,
- 2. audit/inventory of all standing and ad hoc medical staff committees, current committee functions, and current membership
- 3. realignment of medical staff committee functions to current bylaws and rules and regulations
- 4. revising the reporting structure of medical staff committees to be consistent with new bylaws and accreditation standards
- 5. review, revision, reconciliation of all medical staff policies to assure alignment with new bylaws, rules, and regulations.
