**NOTICE OF SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF LOCAL 322
FOR THE PURPOSE OF NOMINATION AND ELECTION OF THE DELEGATES AND
ALTERNATE DELEGATES FROM LOCAL 322
TO THE 42nd GENERAL CONVENTION**

Dear Brother/Sister Member:

In accordance with the Constitution of the United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners of America, you are hereby notified of the Special Called Meeting for the purpose of Nominations and Election of **12 Delegates, 4 Alternate Delegates** from Local 322 to the 42nd General Convention. This notice of Nomination and Election supersedes and replaces any previous General Convention nomination and election notice you have received. The date, time and location of nomination and election is below and in light of the COVID-19 pandemic, the local union has established some additional COVID-19 nomination and election guidelines as enclosed.


Nominations and Elections for the **12** positions of Delegate and Alternate Delegates will be held at the regular membership meeting of Local 322 at **710 Olive Street, St. Paul, MN 55130** on **June 16, 2020** from **4:30 PM to 7:30 PM**. All persons seeking nomination are urged to use the enclosed self-nomination form by mail, or preferably to submit your nomination via email to: local322@ncsrcc.org. All nominations submitted by email or mail must be received at the local union office no later than 5:30 PM, which is the start of the election.

An election by secret ballot for the 12 positions of Delegate and Alternate Delegates will be held at **710 Olive Street, St. Paul, MN 55130** on **June 16, 2020** from **5:30 PM to 7:30 PM**. Any and all Run Off Elections will be held at this same time and location. Social distancing will be strictly enforced at all times.

The term of all Delegates and Alternate Delegate(s) elected shall be for the 42nd General Convention on Saturday, August 22nd, 2020 via electronic conferencing technology. All elected General Convention Delegates and Alternate Delegates from local unions affiliated with the North Central States Regional Council of Carpenters will be notified of specified locations within the North Central States Regional Council of Carpenters from which they will be able to electronically attend the General Convention.

In addition to other eligibility criteria under the United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners of America (UBC), the Labor Management Reporting and Disclosure Act (LMRDA) and other applicable law, members must have been a member for two consecutive years and a member of Local 322 for twelve consecutive months prior to nomination. In order to vote, members must be a member for twelve consecutive months, immediately prior to election, and a member in good standing at the time of election. Further voting eligibility and all other matters relating to nomination and elections within Local 322 are handled in accordance with the Constitution of the UBC, the LMRDA, other applicable law, and duly adopted election rules and procedures of Local 322.
