


# PVP Watch Newsletter – August 2020

Dear Candidate,

PVP Watch is a civic group on the Palos Verdes Peninsula that periodically publishes a newsletter regarding issues affecting the Peninsula.

Our next one will feature elections for city councils in Rolling Hills, Rolling Hills Estates and Palos Verdes Estates, as well as the races for positions on the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School

District Board and the Palos Verdes Library District Board.

We request recipients of this e-mail submit their platforms by e-mail to [cjruona@cox.net](mailto:cjruona@cox.net). Feel free to include any website or campaign e-mail address you are utilizing. Also, if you want to meet with PVP Watch to discuss your candidacy, the major issues facing you if elected and how you plan to confront those issues notify me in the same e-mail.

Since absentee ballots will be mailed out within weeks, we want to publish our newsletter as soon as possible. Therefore, return your e-mail to me with requested information immediately. The newsletter will be sent out with, or without your information.

PVP Watch will publish each candidate's platform as well as the fruits of the candidate interview if PVP Watch feels that information is newsworthy.

PVP Watch normally meets at 10:00 A.M. the first and third Wednesday of the month at Trump National Golf Course. The length of interviews will depend upon how many of the 23 candidates being invited accept our invitation. When submitting your platform advise when an interview is convenient for you and PVP Watch will try to accommodate each candidate.

PVP Watch may endorse candidates based on their positions regarding issues facing the community, or it might remain neutral. We will articulate this in our newsletter along with our rationale. Each candidate will be mentioned. Readers will be advised that PVP Watch invited all candidates to submit platforms and were asked to be interviewed.

Our newsletter is sent to 2,008 e-mail addresses, most if not all on the Peninsula. Many of these are forwarded on to friends, relatives and clients in our community. This is a way to have your message brought to a significant number of constituents.
