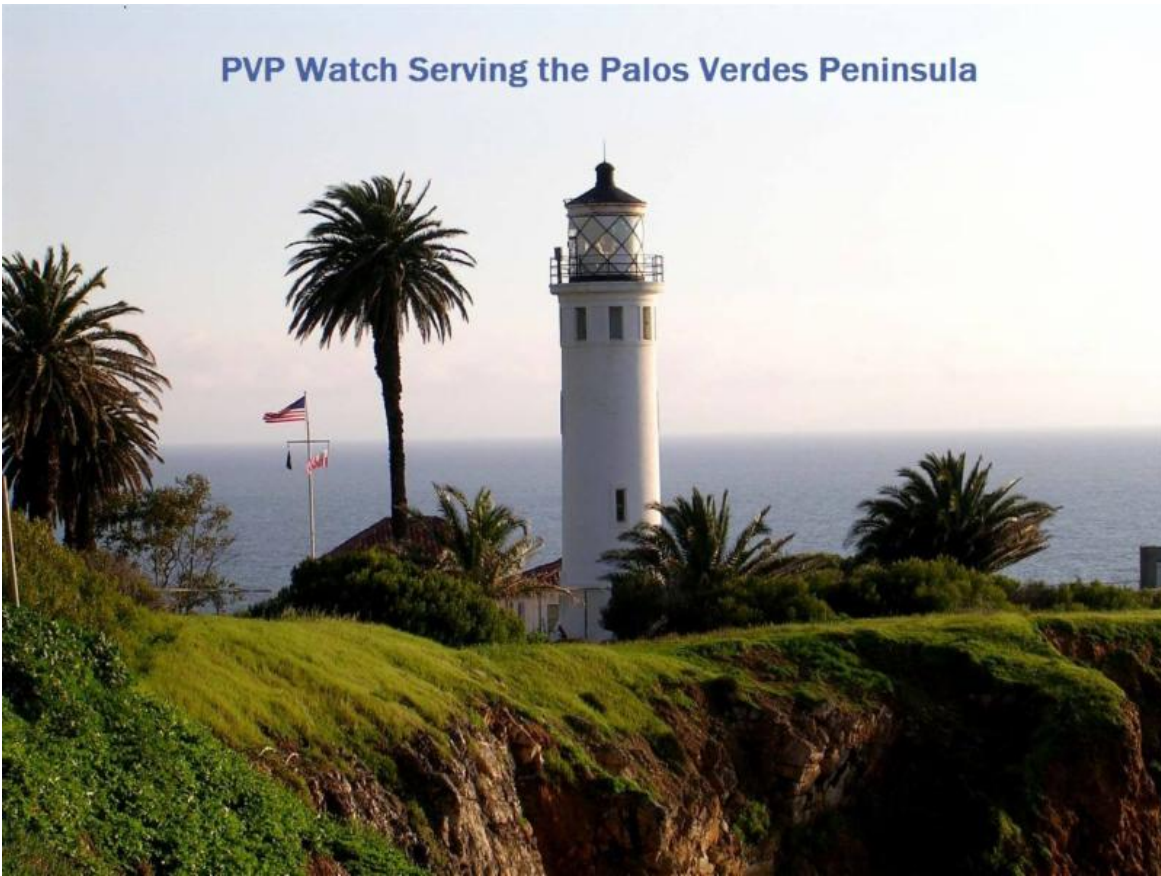

## **PLEASE VOTE**

Voting season is here! Do you remember when on election day you walked to your local precinct and voted? Well that is no longer the case. There are now Vote Centers and they will not only be open from 7:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M. on Tuesday, November 3, 2020, but at various other times as well.

### **VOTE CENTERS**

This is important information from the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk regarding Vote Centers. That office stresses that Vote Centers are subject to change and to visit [LAVote.net](http://LAVote.net) for the most current list of Vote Centers in Los Angeles County.

- All Vote Centers will be open from October 30<sup>th</sup> until November 2<sup>nd</sup> from 10: A.M. until 7:00 P.M.
- On election day, November 3<sup>rd</sup> all Vote Centers will be open from 7:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M.
- Select Vote Centers will be open from October 24<sup>th</sup> until November 2<sup>nd</sup> from 10:00 A.M. until 7:00 P.M. These will be noted.

## **Rancho Palos Verdes**

1. *Miraleste Intermediate School Gymnasium* at 29323 Palos Verdes Drive East
2. *Pacific Unitarian Church Fellowship Hall* at 5621 Montemalaga Drive
3. *Ridgecrest Intermediate School Auditorium* at 28915 Northbay Road
4. *The Rancho Palos Verdes (RPV) City Clerk's office* advises that besides these Vote Centers in RPV the following will also be available for one day only but NOT on election day.
  - Saturday, October 24<sup>th</sup> (**one day only**) from 10:00 A.M. until 6:00 P.M. at *Ladera Linda Community Center* (classroom) at 32201 Forrestal Drive
  - Monday, October 26<sup>th</sup> (**one day only**) from 10:00 A.M. until 6:00 P.M. at *RPV City Hall Community Room* at 30940 Hawthorne Boulevard
  - Wednesday, October 28<sup>th</sup> (**one day only**) from 10:00 A.M. until 6:00 P.M. at *Fred Hesse Community Park* parking lot inside a mobile unit at 23301 Hawthorne Boulevard.

The RPV city clerk's office pointed out that any Los Angeles County resident who is registered to vote can utilize any of these Vote Centers. Voters can also drop off any mail in ballot, or absentee ballot at the Vote Centers.

There is a large secure *ballot receptacle* at *RPV City Hall*, 30940 Hawthorne Boulevard, **outside near the flagpole**, where voters can deposit their ballots 24 hours a day, every day until 8:00 P.M. on November 3<sup>rd</sup>. The ballots from this are picked up on a regular basis by county voting officials.

The RPV's City Clerk's office advises that if a voter wants to know if their ballot was picked up from the ballot box and counted they

can register at <https://california.ballottrax.net/voter/>.

### **Palos Verdes Estates**

1. *Palos Verdes High School* Multi-Purpose Room at 600 Cloyden Road

There is a large secure *ballot receptacle* at *PVE City Hall*, 340 Palos Verdes Drive West, where voters can deposit their ballots 24 hours a day, every day until 8:00 P.M. on November 3<sup>rd</sup>. The ballots from this are picked up on a regular basis by county officials.

### **Palos Verdes Peninsula**

This is a select Voting Center and open from October 24<sup>th</sup> until November 2<sup>nd</sup> from 10:00 A.M. until 7:00 P.M. at *South Coast Botanic Gardens Frances Young Hall* at 26300 Crenshaw Boulevard.

### **Rolling Hills Estates**

1. *Dapple Gray Elementary School* Multi-Purpose Room at 3011 Palos Verdes Drive North
2. *First Baptist Church Calhoun Hall* at 28 Moccasin Lane
3. *Palos Verdes Peninsula High School* Gymnasium at 27118 Silver Spur Road

There is a large secure *ballot receptacle* at *RHE City Hall*, 4045 Palos Verdes Drive North, where voters can deposit their ballots 24 hours a day, every day until 8:00 P.M. on November 3<sup>rd</sup>. The ballots from this are picked up on a regular basis by county voting officials.

- On Wednesday, October 21<sup>st</sup> at 7:00 P.M. the seven candidates running for **three seats on the Rolling Hills City Council** will be featured.
