



## SAFETY REMINDERS FOR REAL ESTATE PROFESSIONALS

- 1. Prioritize personal safety by researching neighborhoods before visiting properties.
- 2. Schedule property viewings during daylight hours for better visibility.
- 3.Inform colleagues or family about your location and schedule when meeting clients.
- 4.Use a reliable GPS app to navigate unfamiliar areas efficiently.
- 5. Have a designated check-in time with someone to ensure your well-being.
- 6. Carry a charged mobile phone for emergencies and have important contacts saved.
- 7. Park in well-lit areas and avoid isolated locations when showing properties.
- 8. Trust your instincts and be cautious if a situation feels uncomfortable.
- 9.Be aware of escape routes and keep keys easily accessible for a quick exit.
- 10. Consider self-defense training for added confidence and preparedness.
- 11. Use virtual tours or video calls whenever possible to minimize in-person meetings.
- 12. Collaborate with other agents when showing properties, especially in remote locations.
- 13. Have a safety protocol in place, such as a distress code, for discreet communication.
- 14. Familiarize yourself with local emergency services and contact information.
- 15. Keep emergency supplies in your vehicle, such as a flashlight and first aid kit.
- 16. Attend safety workshops or seminars to stay informed about potential risks.
- 17. Verify client information before meeting & establish initial contact in a public place.
- 18. Use secure online platforms for communication and document sharing.
- 19. Install a safety app on your phone that can notify others of your location.
