The Black Student Union/Shirley Boykin Scholarship intends to further the vision of Mrs. Boykin by assisting students in furthering Black excellence in education. Shirley's story started in Mississippi where, at the age of 2, her family was forced from their 70 acre land by the sheriff. They moved to Michigan where she pursued a career in health. While at Wayne State University, she overcame prejudice and injustice to obtain her Bachelor's Degree in Biology and Chemistry. Shirley helped many as an occupational therapist, while she and her husband James raised a family of 5 – all of whom went to college.

### ***Purpose:***

To provide financial assistance to a P-CCS graduating senior who has demonstrated leadership for the Black Student Union club.

### ***Amount to be awarded:***

\$500 (non-renewable) to be awarded to two students.

### ***Criteria:***

- Regular attendance at the BSU meetings and participation in events
- BSU has made a positive impact on their time at PCEP
- The student has contributed to the club in a meaningful manner
